Clarifications

Quotation No. MEAIM/EAFRD/011/2014 – Call for Quotations for the Provision of Consultancy Services required for the Monitoring and Control of projects contracted under the European Agricultural Funds for Rural Development (2007 – 2013)

1. Kindly advise if Contracts Circular No 19/2013 related to eliminating the use of experience as a selection criteria and using other selection means to provide more opportunities for SME's applies for this call in question.

Please note that any reference to experience required in the call for quotations MEAIM/EAFRD/011/2014 is being revoked in line with Contracts Circular No. 19/2013. As a result the evaluation will not take into account experience as a selection criteria. Therefore Contracts Circular No 19/2013 applies to this call for quotations.

2. *"Certified involvement during the past 5 years as Project Manager in at least 3 successfully completed civil works project of a value not less than Eur 300,000, as shall be certified by past employers and/or clients by means of letter of reference"* If instead of 3 different projects that add up to €300,000, the project manager was involved in 1 major project that costed around €12,000,000 would that be sufficient?

As per clarification 1, any reference to experience required in the call for quotations MEAIM/EAFRD/011/2014 is being revoked in line with Contracts Circular No. 19/2013. As a result the evaluation will not take into account experience as a selection criteria. Therefore the fact that the project manager could potentially be involved in one major project that costed around €12,000,000 is no longer relevant, as experience will not be taken into account in the evaluation.

3. Are bidders obliged to submit quotes for the three different roles (project manager, architect and civil engineer and support staff) or can bidders just quote for one or two of the roles?

Please note that bidders are obliged to submit quotes for the three (3) different roles.
